<u>Core Indicators Dashboard</u> - The dashboard re-visualizes the Core Indicator data from the Chancellor's Office website.

Phase 1 (January 2024) includes two primary content areas:

- 1. 2023-24 Core Indicator data by top code this tab will always show the most recent year available by top code by college
- 2. Performance overtime this tab will show you insight into your performance overtime

Note: Phase 2 – we will be an expansion of the dashboard to provide college level views (rather than just program level by college). Phase 3 will add districtwide views.
