

DESCRIPTION

- 1. The <u>degree</u> you will earn and <u>college</u> of graduation.
- 2. CATALOG YEAR of the requirements for your program.
- 3. DEGREE REQS MET indicates
 - YES you have completed the degree requirements
 - NO continue looking through the evaluation for the specific requirements that have not been completed
 - PENDING you are currently enrolled in the required course/s, you must complete the courses with a 'C' or higher.
- 4a/b. Pay close attention to the REQUIREMENTS MET for each area. (YES | NO | PENDING)
- 5a. As you read through the evaluation, the REQUIRED COURSES are on the left under SUBJ/CRSE, and the course you took showing how you met the requirement is to the right.
- 5b. If the course was transferred in from another institution, it will show with a 'T' indicating transfer.

- 7. Heading can have several areas.

- 8. Each area has specific requirements.
 - Example for A: COMM IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE:
 - Oral Communication
 - Written Communication
 - Critical Thinking
