

Understanding a Graduation Evaluation – A Sample

Note: The sample shown here may be slightly different than your actual evaluation due to program differences.

DESCRIPTION

1. The degree you will earn and college of graduation.
2. CATALOG YEAR of the requirements for your program.
3. DEGREE REQS MET indicates
 - **YES** - you have completed the degree requirements
 - **NO** – continue looking through the evaluation for the specific requirements that have not been completed
 - **PENDING** – you are currently enrolled in the required course/s, you must complete the courses with a 'C' or higher.
- 4a/b. Pay close attention to the REQUIREMENTS MET for each area. (YES | NO | PENDING)
- 5a. As you read through the evaluation, the REQUIRED COURSES are on the left under SUBJ/CRSE, and the course you took showing how you met the requirement is to the right.
- 5b. If the course was transferred in from another institution, it will show with a 'T' indicating transfer.

 - Example for A: COMM IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE:
 - Oral Communication
 - Written Communication
 - Critical Thinking
