Administrative Procedure

Chapter 3 – General Institution

AP 3570 - SMOKING ON CAMPUS

The District prohibits smoking and the use of tobacco products on all properties and in all vehicles owned or controlled by the District. Smoking, vaping, and the use of tobacco products is prohibited on all District property at all times. This administrative procedure applies to students, faculty, staff, administrators, and general members of the public.

This prohibition includes the use of tobacco products, including but not limited to: cigarettes, cigars, little cigars, chewing tobacco, pipe tobacco, snuff, hookahs, and an electronic device that delivers nicotine or other vaporized liquids to a person inhaling from the device (e.g., e-cigarettes and vaporizers).

District property includes both indoor and outdoor areas of property that is owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by the District, including but not limited to: classrooms, offices, lobbies, lounges, waiting areas, stairwells, restrooms, walkways, sidewalks, lawns, athletic fields and viewing stands, parking lots, warehouses, storage yards, and District-owned or leased vehicles.

The District offers the Smoking Cessation Program referrals at the Student Health Centers, for students, faculty, and staff who are interested in quitting smoking or the use of tobacco.
