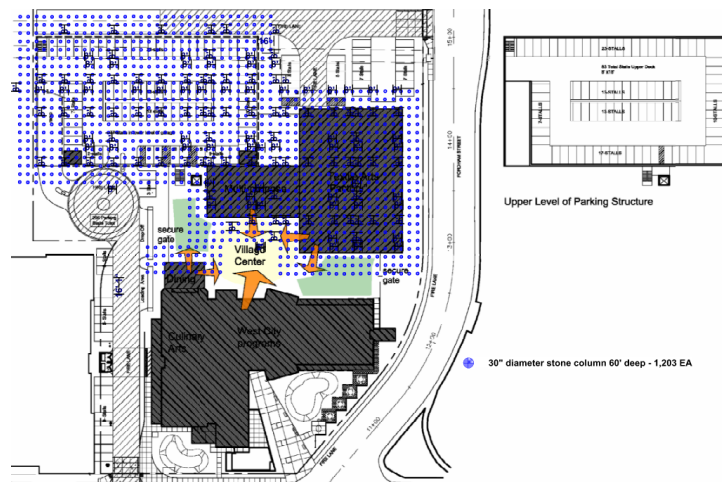

## Project Insights

The project is nearing the end of the Programming Phase with DPR and HGA as the design build team. Over the first 60 days, the team engaged College stakeholders and District leadership to refine the space program, confirm adjacencies, and validate department needs. They also advanced early test fit layouts and reviewed site considerations to stay aligned with project goals and constraints. Preliminary presentations to College leadership for feedback and direction completed this month.

## Project Features

The San Diego College of Continuing Education West City Expansion project includes approximately 10,800 assignable square feet (ASF) of new building construction, the modernization of a portion of the existing facility, and the construction of a new parking garage in accordance with the campus's long-term Master Plan. The project will expand or enhance the following programs:

- Culinary Arts
- Clothing and Textiles
- Community Room
- Outdoor Gathering Space
- Emeritus Program

Other improvements include:

- New utility infrastructure, sustainable landscaping and irrigation
- Construction of exterior walkways, sidewalk, curb and gutter improvements along adjoining street frontages
- Accessible path of travel to designated parking
- Exterior and interior signage
