Which Metric? Different metrics answer different questions about "Enrollment Management"


Headcount

Enrollment

FTES



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
FTES: A "full-time equivalent student" is an enrolled student who attends 15 hours each week during the semester. In an academic year, this hypothetical full-time student generates 525 student contact hours (<u>CCCCO</u>, <u>2019</u>).



FTES: Full Time Equivalent Student

For an individual enrollment, FTES is attendance hours for that class divided by 525.

Most individual enrollments generate 0.1 FTES



FTES: Full Time Equivalent Student

For a section, FTES is total attendance hours by students in that section divided by 525.



FTES: Full Time Equivalent Student


FTES calculations are as complex as the educational offerings at SDCCD.

- Positive Attendance
- Credit vs. Non-credit
- Laboratory/Independent Study
- Distance Education non-credit
- Fiscal year vs. Academic Year

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
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
FTES: A calculated percentage of how many full-time students are represented by each enrollment or section.
