



Title IX Intercollegiate Sports Interest Survey
Miramar College, Fall 2024
October 15, 2024

Background

The data in this report was collected by the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) in accordance with the Title IX Equal Opportunity in Education Act to determine applicants' level of interest in intercollegiate athletics and whether the colleges are fulfilling the expressed demand of their applicants for opportunities to participate in sports. Data was collected from applicants who completed CCCApply in January through September of 2024 in an optional survey included in the application.

The sports listed in Table 1 are offered to student athletes at Miramar College.

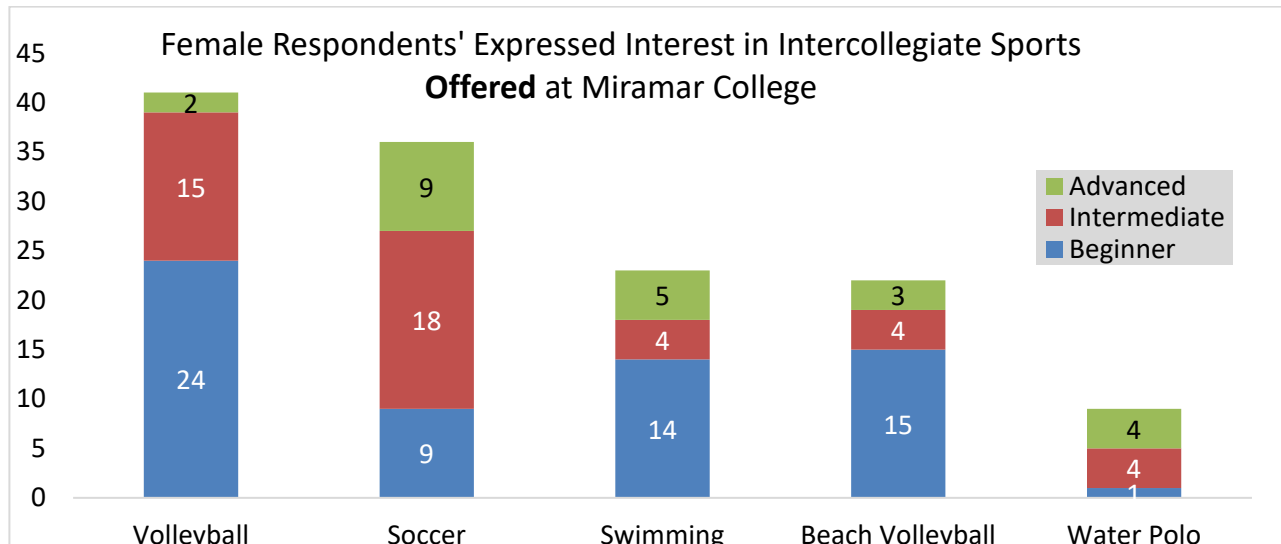

Respondents' Interest in Intercollegiate Athletics

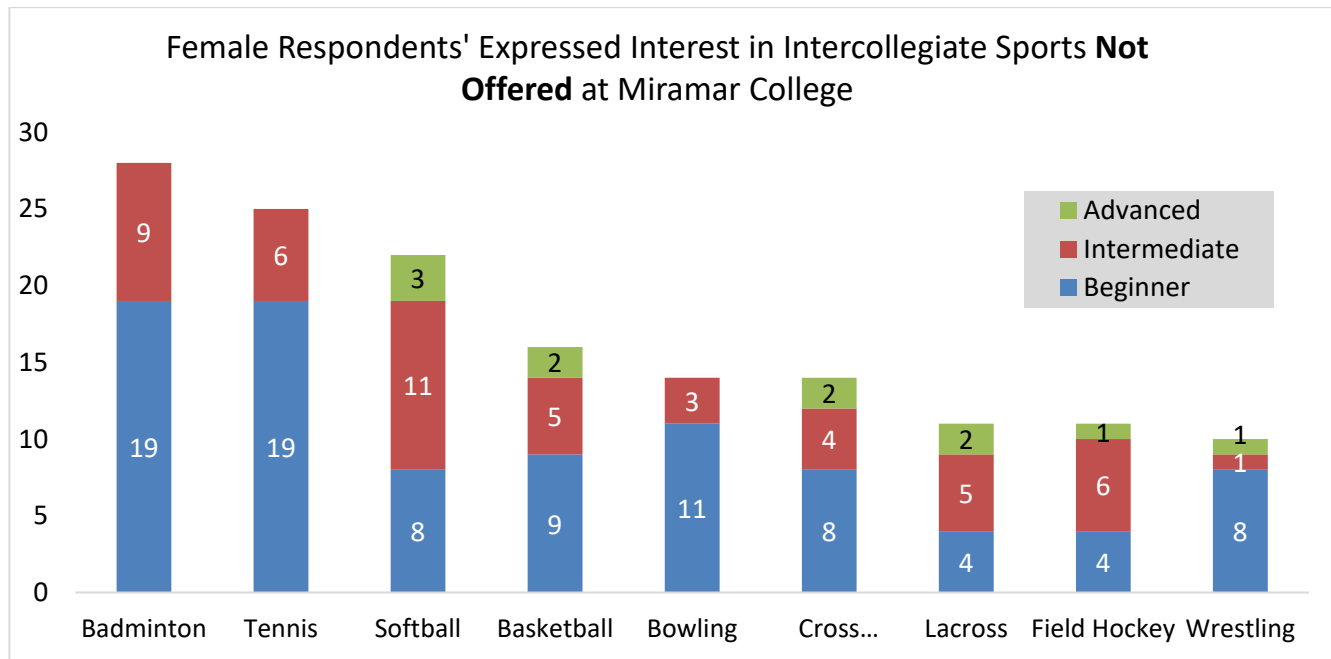
Of the 636 respondents to the survey in CCCApply, 360 indicated they were interested in competing in intercollegiate sports (57%). 161 of these were **female (45%** of those interested in competing) and 199 of these were **male (55%** of those interested in competing). Of those who indicated they were interested, 308 students provided email addresses to be contacted about intercollegiate sports at Miramar College (female: 131, male: 177).

Female Applicants' Responses

When female applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in volleyball (n=41), which is offered at Miramar. The majority of these respondents indicated they were beginners (24), and 17 indicated they were intermediate or advanced.



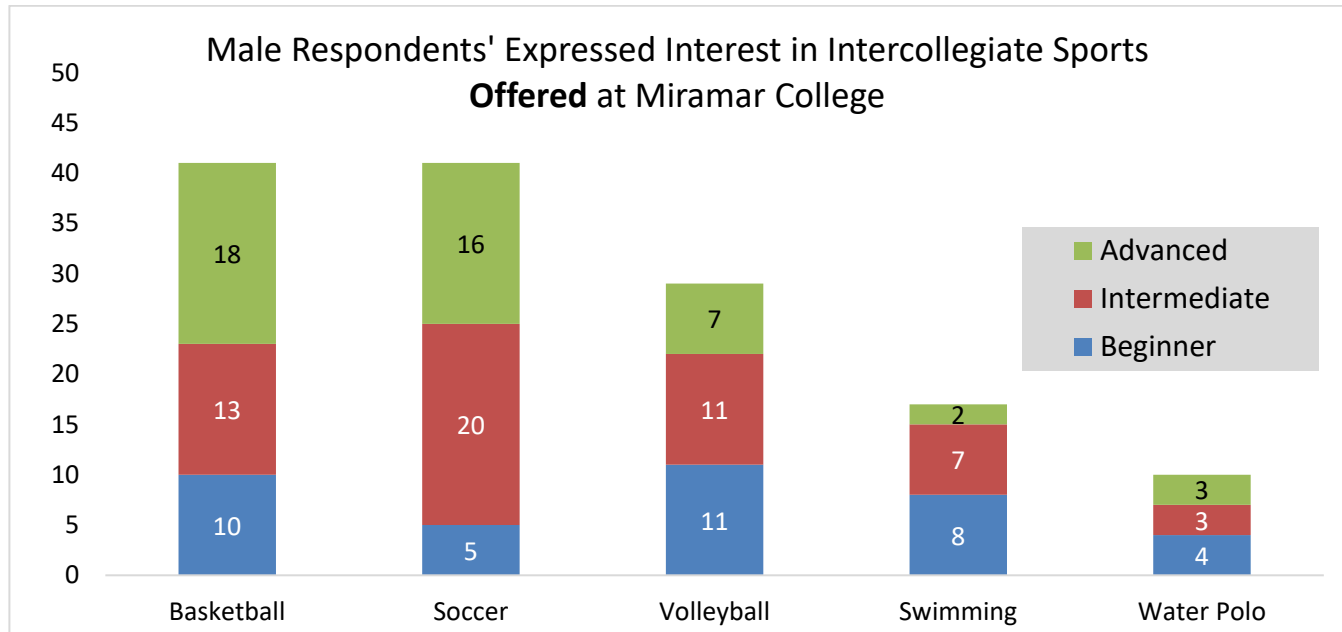
28 respondents indicated they would be interested in badminton, and another 25 indicated they would be interested in tennis, neither of which is offered at Miramar College.

Male Applicants' Responses

When male applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in basketball and soccer (41 applicants each), which are offered at Miramar.



The sports not offered at Miramar for which male applicants most commonly expressed interest were football (32 respondents) and baseball (30 respondents).
