



Title IX Intercollegiate Sports Interest Survey
Mesa College, Fall 2025

Background

The data in this report was collected by the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) in accordance with the Title IX Equal Opportunity in Education Act to determine applicants' level of interest in intercollegiate athletics and whether the colleges are fulfilling the expressed demand of their applicants for opportunities to participate in sports. Data was collected from applicants who completed CCCApply in October 2024 through September 2025 in an optional survey included in the application.

The sports listed in Table 1 are offered to student athletes at Mesa College.

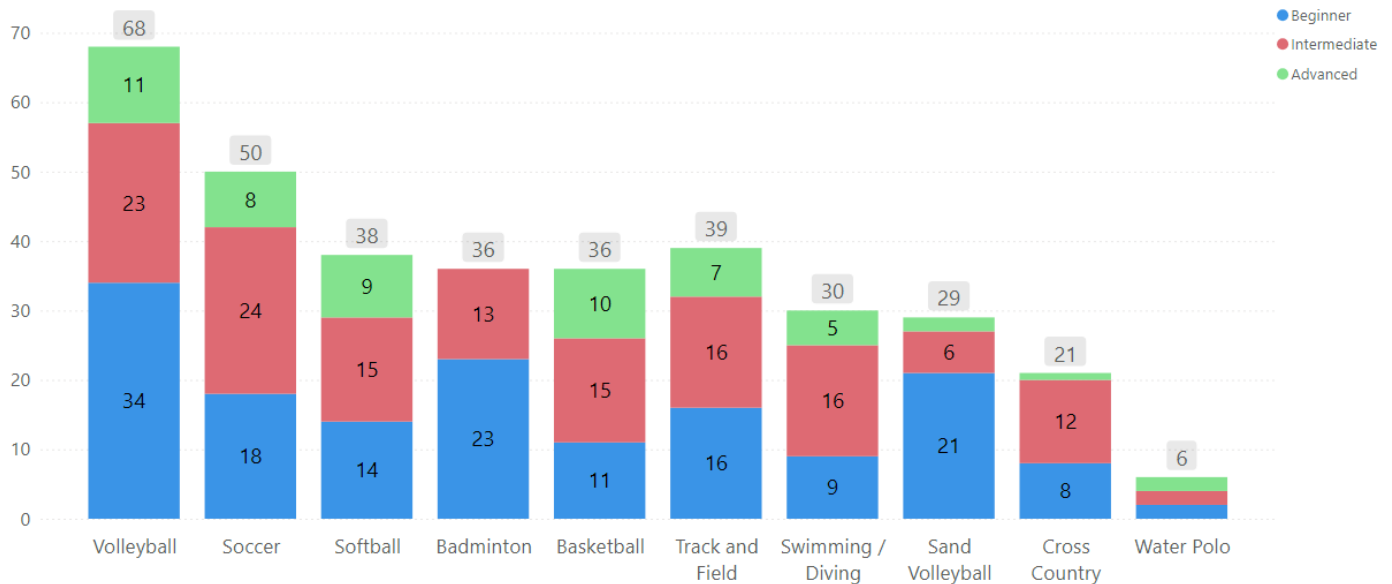
Respondents' Interest in Intercollegiate Athletics

Of the 864 respondents to the survey in CCCApply, 508 indicated they were interested in competing in intercollegiate sports (59%). 255 of these were **female** (50% of those interested in competing) and 253 of these were **male** (50% of those interested in competing). Of those who indicated they were interested, 443 students provided email addresses to be contacted about intercollegiate sports at Mesa College (female: 215, male: 228).

Female Applicants' Responses

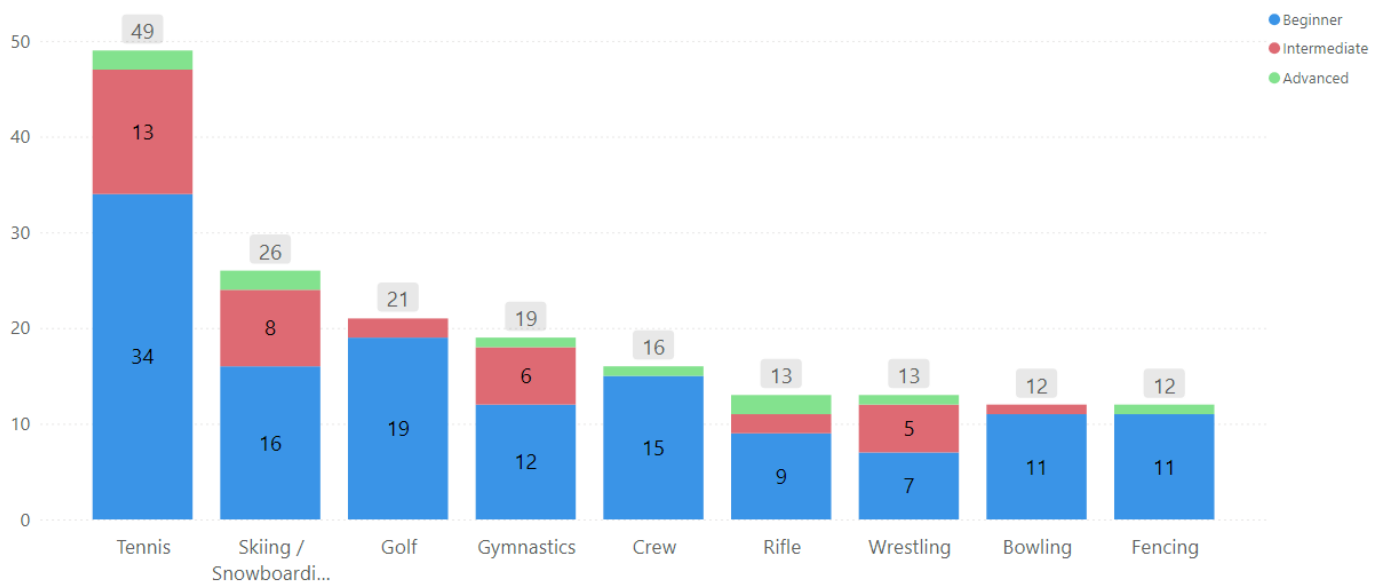
When female applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in volleyball (n=68) and soccer (n=50), which are both offered at Mesa College.

The sport not currently offered at Mesa College for which the largest number of respondents expressed interest was tennis (n=49), with 34 respondents indicating they were beginners

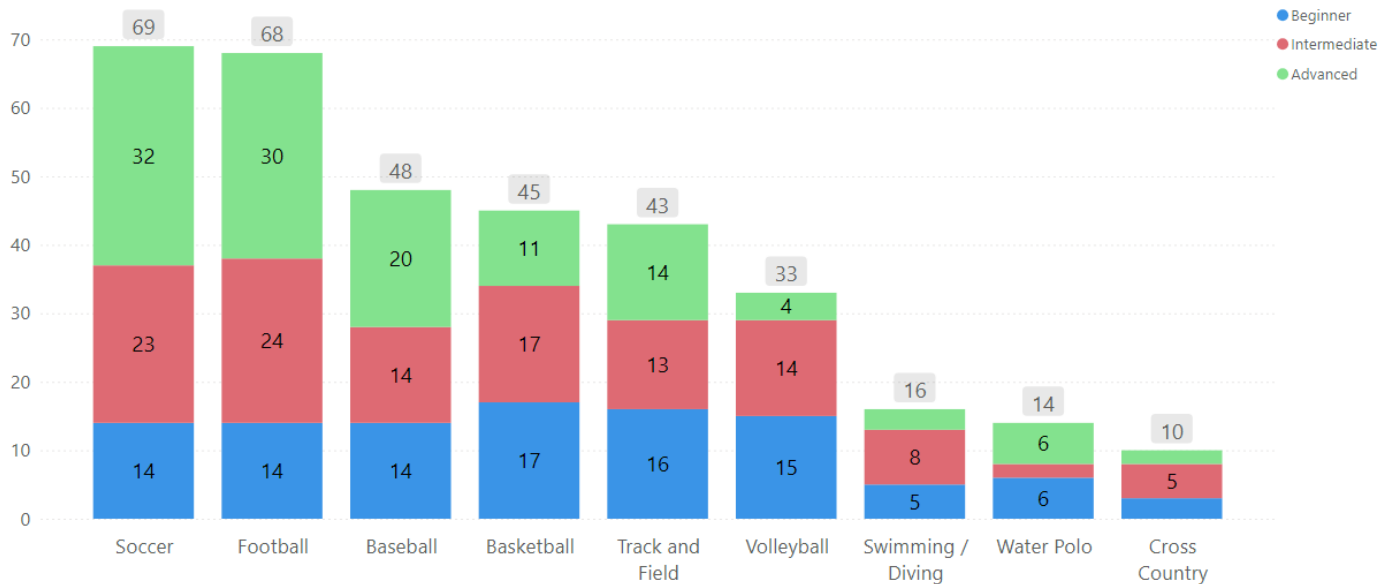
Female Respondents' Expressed Interest in Intercollegiate Sports Not Offered at Mesa College



Male Applicants' Responses

When male applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in soccer (n=69) and football (n=68), both of which are offered at Mesa College.

The sport not currently offered at Mesa College for which the most respondents expressed interest was wrestling, with 12 respondents indicating they were beginners, 13 indicating they were intermediate, and 1 indicated they were advanced.
