



Title IX Intercollegiate Sports Interest Survey
Miramar College, Fall 2025

Background

The data in this report was collected by the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) in accordance with the Title IX Equal Opportunity in Education Act to determine applicants' level of interest in intercollegiate athletics and whether the colleges are fulfilling the expressed demand of their applicants for opportunities to participate in sports. Data was collected from applicants who completed CCCApply in October 2024 through September 2025 in an optional survey included in the application.

The sports listed in Table 1 are offered to student athletes at Miramar College.

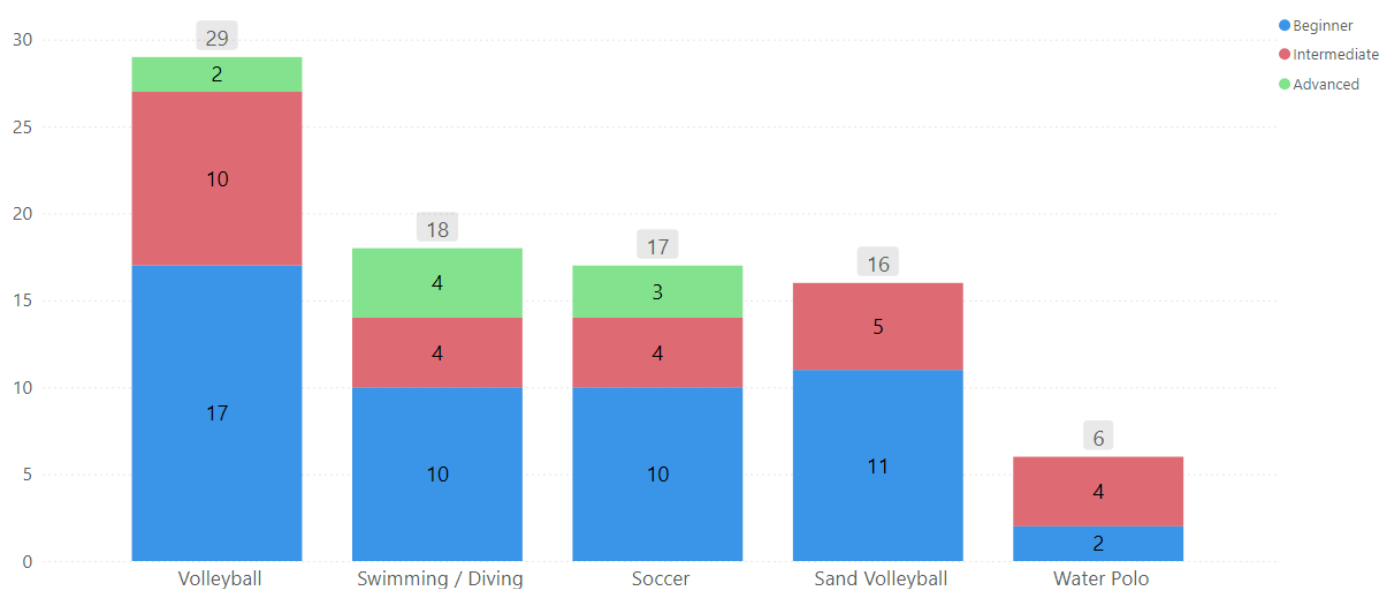
Respondents' Interest in Intercollegiate Athletics

Of the 455 respondents to the survey in CCCApply, 249 indicated they were interested in competing in intercollegiate sports (55%). 98 of these were **female (39%** of those interested in competing) and 151 of these were **male (61%** of those interested in competing). Of those who indicated they were interested, 209 students provided email addresses to be contacted about intercollegiate sports at Miramar College (female: 77, male: 132).

Female Applicants' Responses

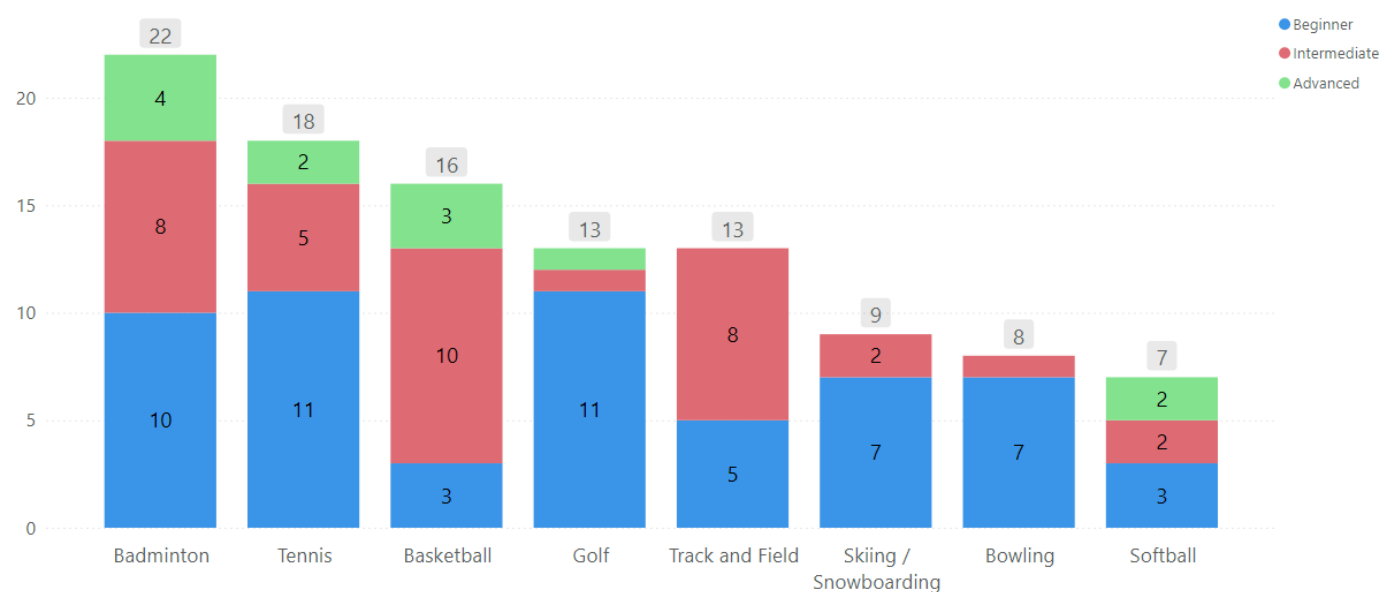
When female applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in volleyball (n=29), which is offered at Miramar. The majority of these respondents indicated they were beginners (17), and 12 indicated they were intermediate or advanced.

22 respondents indicated they would be interested in badminton, and another 18 indicated they would be interested in tennis, neither of which is offered at Miramar College.

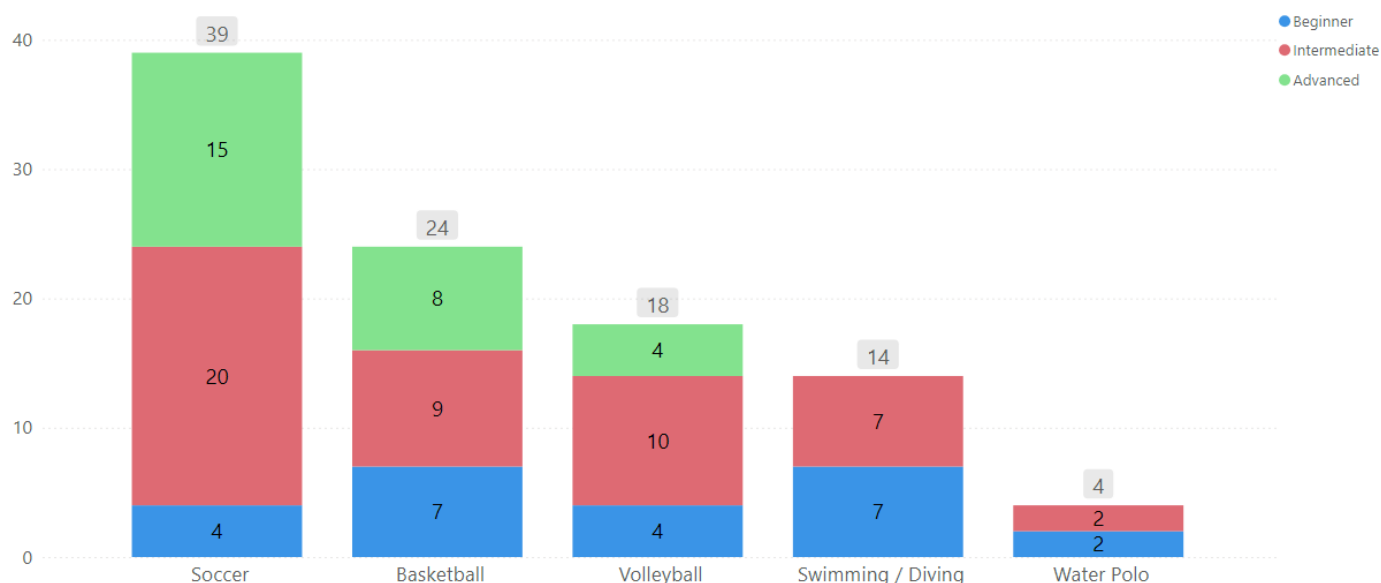
Female Respondents' Expressed Interest in Intercollegiate Sports Not Offered at Miramar College



Male Applicants' Responses

When male applicants indicated that they would be interested in competing in a sport, they most commonly expressed interest in soccer (n=39) and basketball (n=24), both of which are offered at Miramar.
