Context

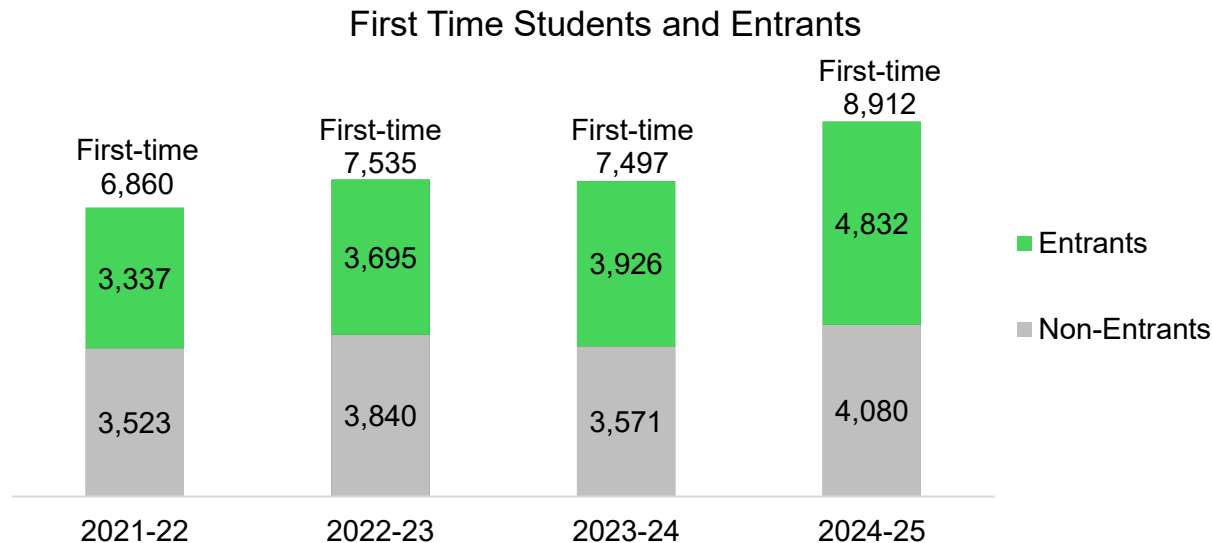
How many students from Service Area high schools attend City/Mesa/Miramar within one year of high school graduation?

- **2024-25 First Time Entrants**
 - ✓ graduated high school in 2024
 - ✓ enrolled at City/Mesa/Miramar in Summer 2024, Fall 2025, and/or Spring 2025
- **Entrant Rate:** $\text{Entrants} \div \text{High School Seniors}$
- Excludes SDCCE due to application data availability

The Big Picture, 2024-25: First Time Students

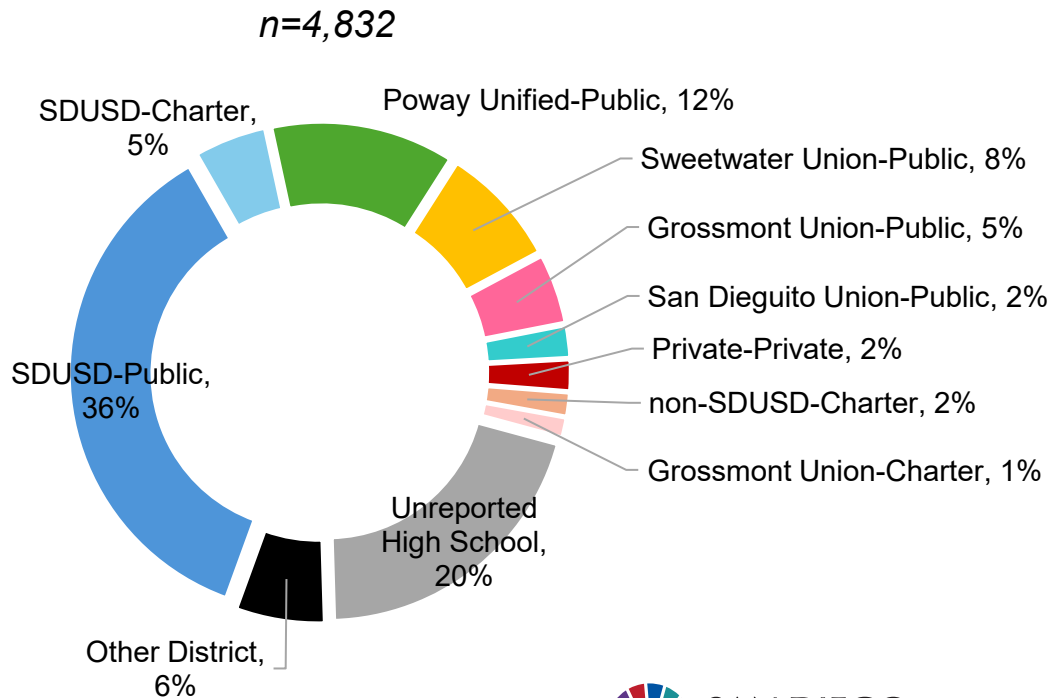
- Just over half of students who are first-time to college are recent high school graduates

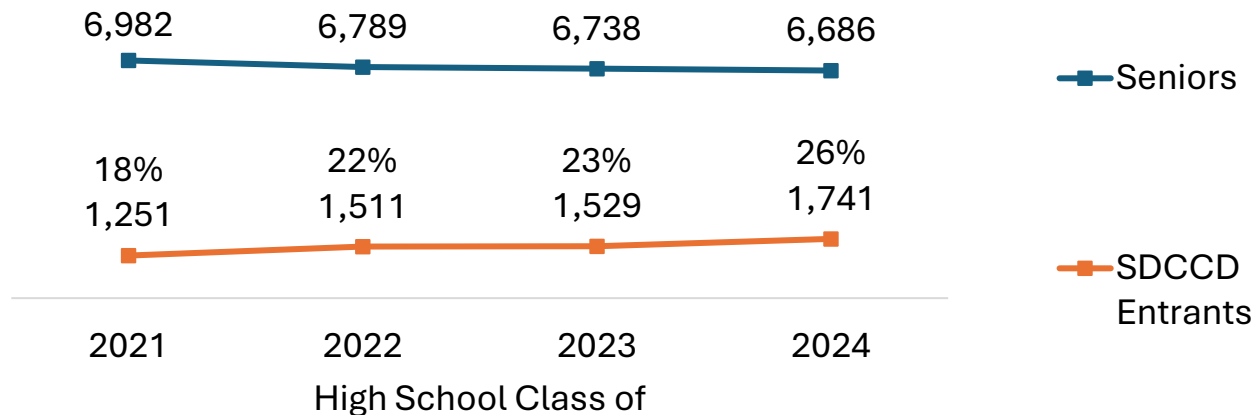

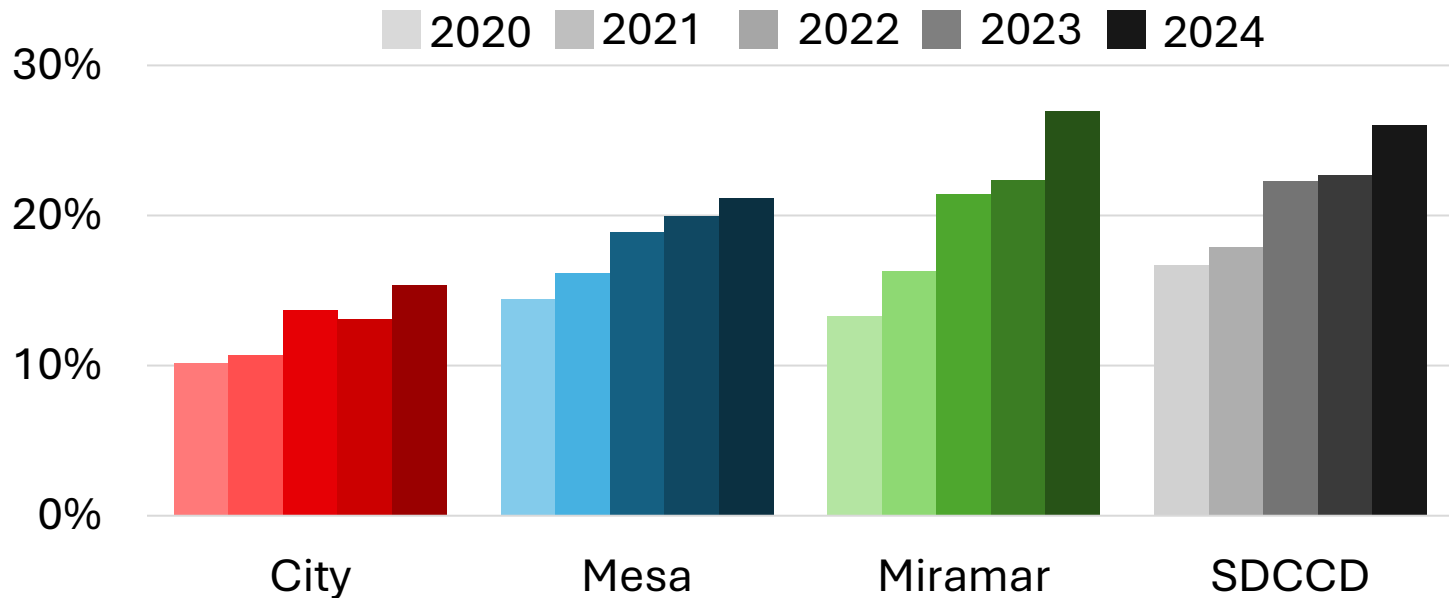
Trends: SDUSD Public School Entrant Rate

- In 2024-25, 26% of the students who graduated high school in 2024 enrolled at San Diego City, Mesa, or Miramar College.
- This is up from 2023-24, when 23% of seniors enrolled at SDCCCD.

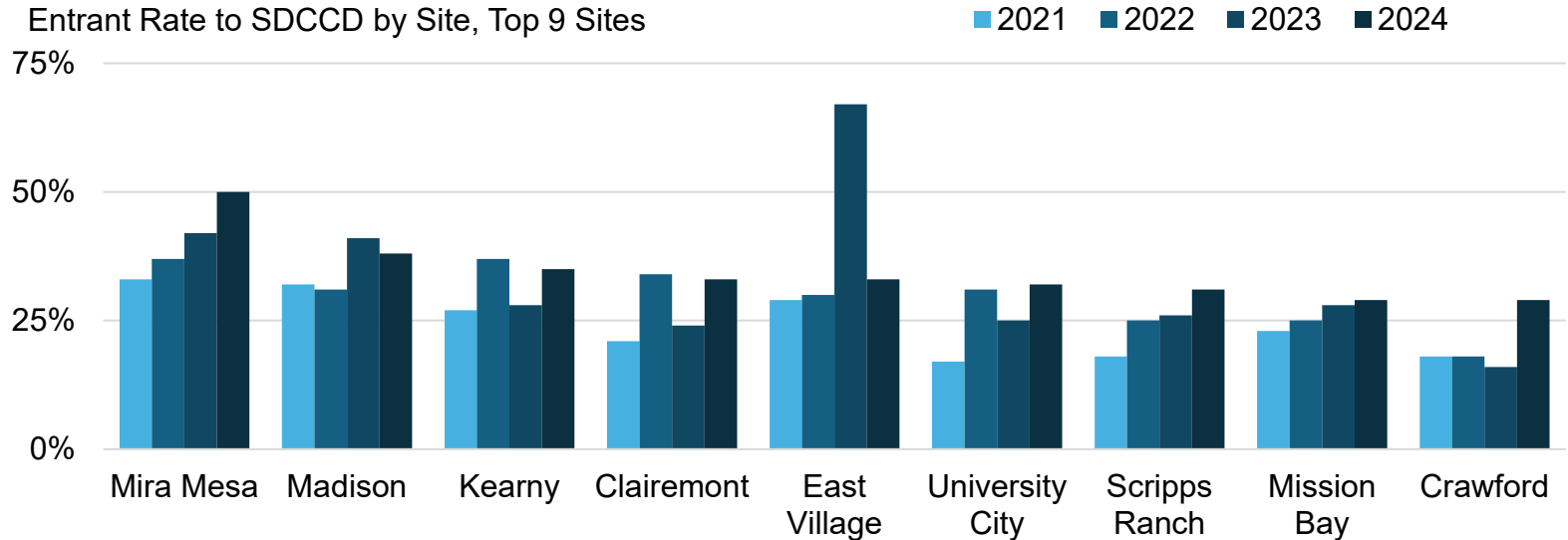

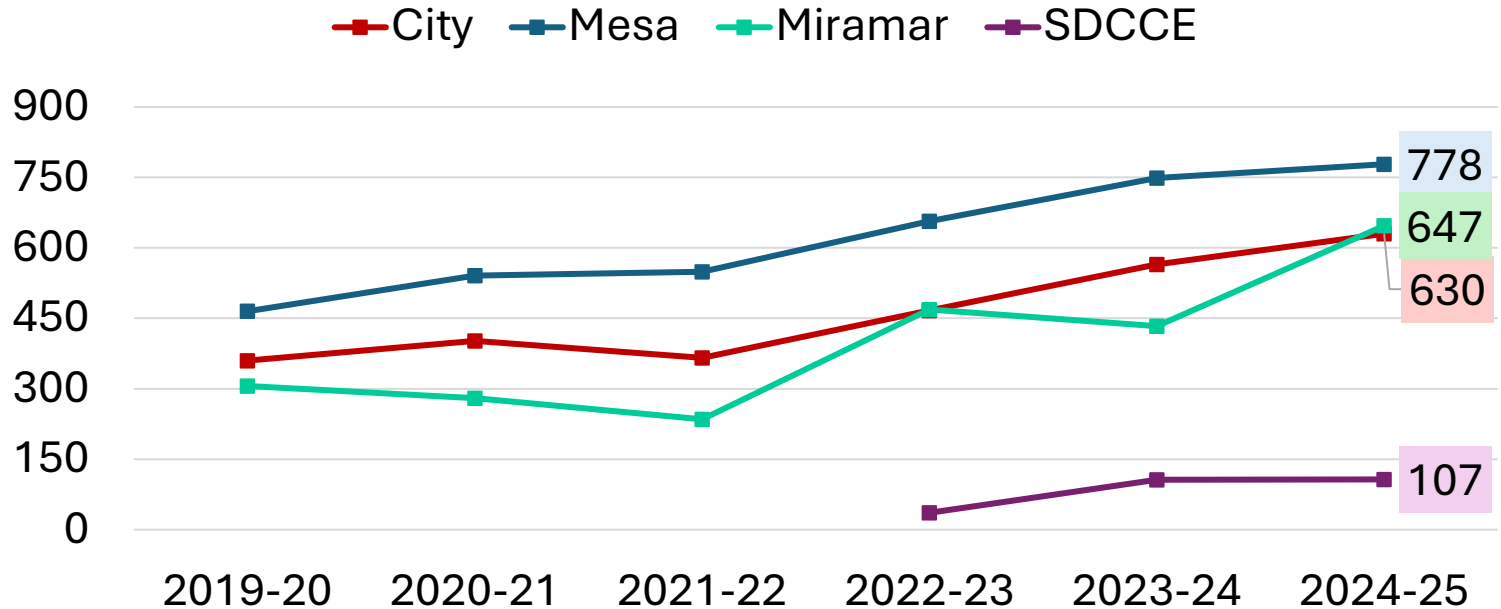

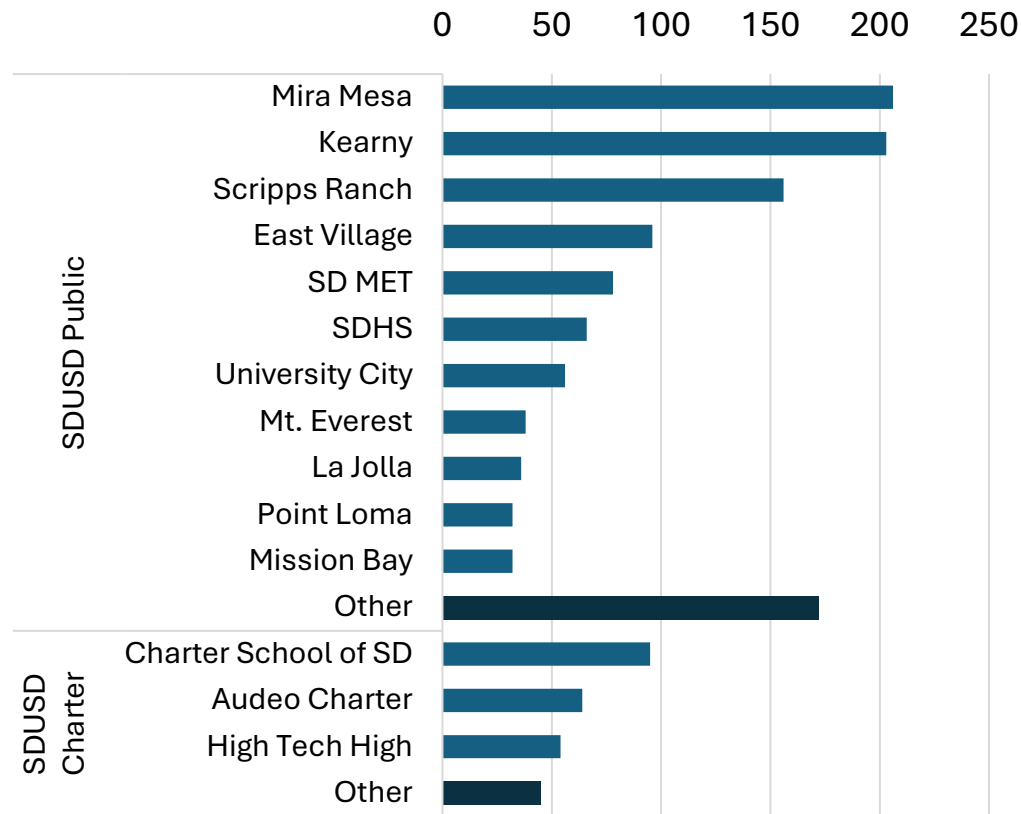
Concurrent Enrollment
