Context


How many students from Service Area high schools attend City/ Mesa/Miramar within one year of high school graduation?


- 2024-25 First Time Entrants

 Just over half of students who are first-time to college are recent high school graduates








The Big Picture, 2024-25: First Time Entrants by High School District




Trends: SDUSD Public School Entrant Rate

- In 2024-25, 26% of the students who graduated high school in 2024 enrolled at San Diego City, Mesa, or Miramar College.
- This is up from 2023-24, when 23% of seniors enrolled at SDCCD.





Concurrent Enrollment


Headcount, 2024-25
