Important SDCCE Updates for CTE Transitions Credit by Exam

SDCCE is working to improve the student experience and success within the SDCCE CTE Transitions Credit by Exam process. Student Processes and requirements have changed for fall 2022 enrollments.

Summary of Changes:

- New Icon for increased visibility of opportunity to receive credit through credit by exam process
- Opt-in Model in place as of fall 2022
 - Students no longer have to take the extra step to request college credit
- Faculty no longer have to enter grades in the external Instructor Certification Process
- Increased support for completing the credit College Application (CCCApply) is available

- Use of My To Do List for all grade eligible students
- Engagement from Credit Colleges
- Improved student communication at time of enrollment, at time of grade eligibility, etc.
- Increased counselor training
