

## CTE Transitions Credit by Exam DAC Update November 2023

### Renewal Updates

Fall renewals are underway for all active agreements set to expire in 2024. The initial approval has been solicited via email to discipline faculty for 30 SDUSD and Out of District agreements and 12 SDCCE agreements at City, Mesa and Miramar. Once confirmed, renewal agreements will be distributed for signature approval via DocuSign.

### Agreement Development Updates

- **City College**
  - Noncredit to City
    - INWT 100 – *No substantive changes since Sept 2023 update*
      - Course alignment and final assessments are being reviewed to reactivate the agreement between SDCCE and City College. Materials are currently being reviewed by City College faculty.
        - SDCCE Dean and Vice President expressed priority focus on this agreement
- **Mesa College**
  - SDUSD to Mesa
    - NUTR 160 - *No changes since the Sept 2023 update*
      - SDUSD expressed interest in adding an additional high school course to articulate with an existing NUTR 160 agreement Nutrition 1,2
      - Waiting for faculty feedback.
      - College course already approved for CBE and tied to active agreement
    - BIOL 160 - *No changes since the Sept 2023 update*
      - SDUSD expressed interest in agreement development with their Human Body Systems 1,2 / Honors Human Body Systems 1,2 (currently articulated to MEDA 055; SDUSD seeking alternative college course)
      - Course is not yet approved for CBE
      - Waiting on faculty response
    - EXSC 242B - *No changes since the Sept 2023 update*
      - Waiting on faculty response
      - DAC approved during December 2022 meeting
      - Course is not yet approved for CBE
  - Out-of-District/Charter to Mesa
    - Culinary (NEW) - Request from Ramona high school to articulate culinary courses with Mesa College.
      - Palomar College does not offer culinary

- No courses have been selected
  - ARCH – *Progress made:*
    - Mesa faculty have confirmed course alignment with ARCH 107 and SDUSD’s Architectural Design 1,2 Honors course. The course has been approved for articulation credit by exam and the agreement is active for 2023-25 academic years.
  - Vet Tech – *no substantive changes since Sept. 2023 update*
    - Altus Charter School submitted curriculum for review; meeting scheduled for November with faculty; no college course selected yet.
  - Child Development – *no changes since Sept 2023 update*
    - SD County office of Education expressed interest in possible articulation; college faculty exploring; no course(s) selected yet
- **Miramar College**
  - SDUSD to Miramar
    - BIOL – NEW
      - Miramar faculty have confirmed alignment with BIOL 132 and SDUSD’s Biotech 3,4 course. This agreement has a 1-year approval for the 2023-24 academic year. Miramar faculty and SDUSD will meet to work out details to continue the agreement in the future. BIOL 132 has been CBE approved.
    - CISC – NEW
      - SDUSD has requested to articulate additional courses with Miramar
        - CISC 190 (Miramar), AP Computer Science (Mesa)
        - Waiting for faculty response
        - Course is not CBE approved yet
    - Fire – NEW
      - Miramar faculty looking to expand FIPT courses with SDUSD; FIPT 100D was previously discussed; No courses selected yet
    - ADJU - NEW
      - SDUSD has requested to articulate additional courses with Miramar; ADJU 102 (Miramar), Criminal Justice 1,2 (SDUSD); Waiting on faculty response; Course is CBE approved

## Overall Course Grade Eligibility

In Spring 2023, in alignment with the SDUSD/SDCCD Joint Board Goals, the Vice Chancellor for Educational Services and Vice Presidents of Instruction at City, Mesa, and Miramar approved a change to the overall course grade eligibility requirements for CTE Transitions high school to college and noncredit to college articulation credit by exam effective fall 2023.

- **Beginning Fall 2023, the overall course grade eligibility requirement for Articulation Credit by Exam is a C- or higher**
  - This change does not impact any existing formal SDCCD Policy or Administrative Procedure nor does it impact the overall process of CTE Transitions Credit by Exam, agreements, or faculty activities tied to the agreements.
  - Updating the overall course grade requirement to C- or higher brings CTE Transitions Credit by Exam course grade eligibility into alignment with other districtwide course success metrics.
  - This change aligns CTE Transitions course success with our high school partners’ course success measures C- or higher is both the SDCCD course success measure (across all four colleges) and K12’s course success measure).
- **No change to course-to-course alignment** - CTE Transitions Articulation Credit by Exam will continue to require course-to -course alignment (no change). Alignment will continue to be confirmed by college faculty and confirmed via the signed agreement.
- **No change to End of Course Grade Eligibility** – End of Course (EOC) grade eligibility will remain unchanged. EOC grade eligibility requires the student to receive a B or higher on the college faculty approved final exam/assessment (no change).
- **No change to the grade that is transcribed** – the grade transcribed to the college transcript will remain the end of course (EOC) grade which will remain B or higher (no change).
