If approved, courses may be used to meet an associate degree or certificate requirements (and in some instances, university credit) and/or advancement to the next level of classes for which the course serves as a prerequisite. Meet with a college counselor to develop a detailed education plan.

The grade a student earns on the approved end of course exam will become the student's college grade.

Student requirements in order to be awarded SDCCD college credit:

STEP 1: Enroll in an approved CTE Transitions class at your high school/adult school

STEP 2: Successfully create a CATEMA profile and select the approved CTE Transitions class(es) that you are enrolled in.

STEP 3: Earn a grade of "C" or better in each section of an approved CTE Transitions class and a 'B' or better on the final exam(s) and/or project

STEP 4: Successfully complete an SDCCD college application online (must be completed within 18 months of high school graduation).

STEP 5: Submit CTE Transitions Program *Student Petition for College Credit* form and **official** high school transcript to CTE Transitions office (must be completed within 18 months of high school graduation).

NOTE: Credit cannot be awarded if Steps 4 and 5 are not completed within 18 months of high school graduation.
