



Regional Consortium Program Recommendations September 2022 Update

San Diego City College

No programs submitted for regional recommendation.

San Diego Mesa College

Two (2) program modifications submitted. Both were endorsed by the Deans Council. Based on submitted labor market information, the programs received cautionary comments by the Centers of Excellence (COE). COE comments are noted below.

- **Coding Specialist (Health Information Technology)**, CoA - Modification
 - COE Comments: *SD Mesa college submitted the appropriate LMI from the COE. The COE does not recommend developing a *new* program for this occupation but supports a program modification because 1) LMI suggests that labor market demand is met with existing programs; 2) entry-level wages are above the living wage; and 3) the majority of awards for these occupations are supplied by noncommunity-college institutions in the region.*
- **Health Information Technology, A.S.** - Modification
 - COE Comments: *SD Mesa college submitted the appropriate LMI from the COE. The COE does not recommend developing a *new* program for this occupation but supports a program modification because 1) LMI suggests that labor market demand is met with existing programs; 2) entry-level wages are above the living wage; and 3) the majority of awards for these occupations are supplied by noncommunity-college institutions in the region.*
