



### **SB1348 Reporting**

**Background:** In September 2018, CA State Legislature passed SB-1348 requiring CCCC to report additional information on clinical placements within degree and certificate programs in allied health. Reporting requires the collection of clinical site license numbers (or EIN), the total number of students placed at each site, and the languages the placed students are proficient in other than English.

## Reporting in NOVA Reminders:

- The “Add Additional Response” button at the bottom of the page allows you to submit another entry
- Each entry is by program and by site - You have to add a response for each clinical site for each program
- NOVA saves all changes automatically - You can add content and make changes as many times as you want prior to submitting
- If you hit submit and need to make a change – click on uncertify. This should allow you to go back in and make changes and then re-submit
- You need license number for each site
- You need language information for all students placed at each site
- If Perkins or SWP funds were used to support clinical placements, you will need to include the unique SWP or Perkins project plan number/ID; The system enables to you search and find the ID (see this video for support at 3:40: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hUgEe0v8Xes>)
