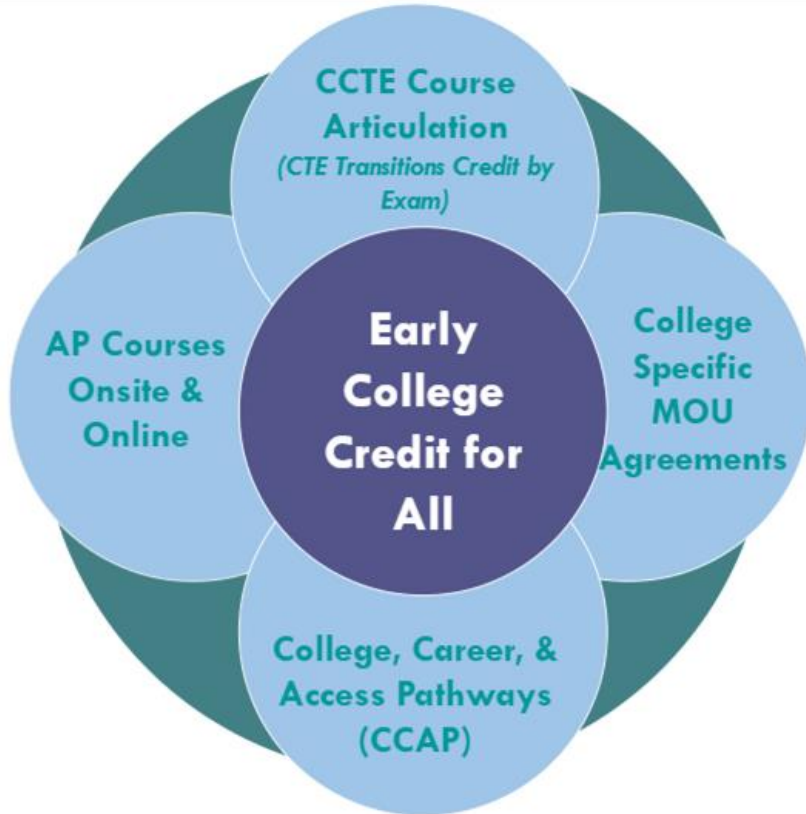

# CTE Transitions Credit by Exam

## CCTE Course Articulation

### Connecting Career Education Pathways from high school to college

*Accelerating career education degree and certificate completion*

- ★ Early College Credit Model
- ★ Connects existing CCTE Pathway high school courses to college career education courses
- ★ Courses taught by high school teachers
- ★ Students who earn a “B” or higher in the course and on the college approved final exam may earn college credit
- ★ College faculty-led agreement development
- ★ Course Alignment and Assessment of Competencies
- ★ Two-year renewable agreements

# Ongoing Overlapping Stages

## Agreement Development

- ★ Exchange curriculum
- ★ Deep review of course competencies and evaluation to assess alignment
- ★ Faculty to Teacher discussions
- ★ Agreement on method of final evaluation within the course
- ★ Approved by college faculty

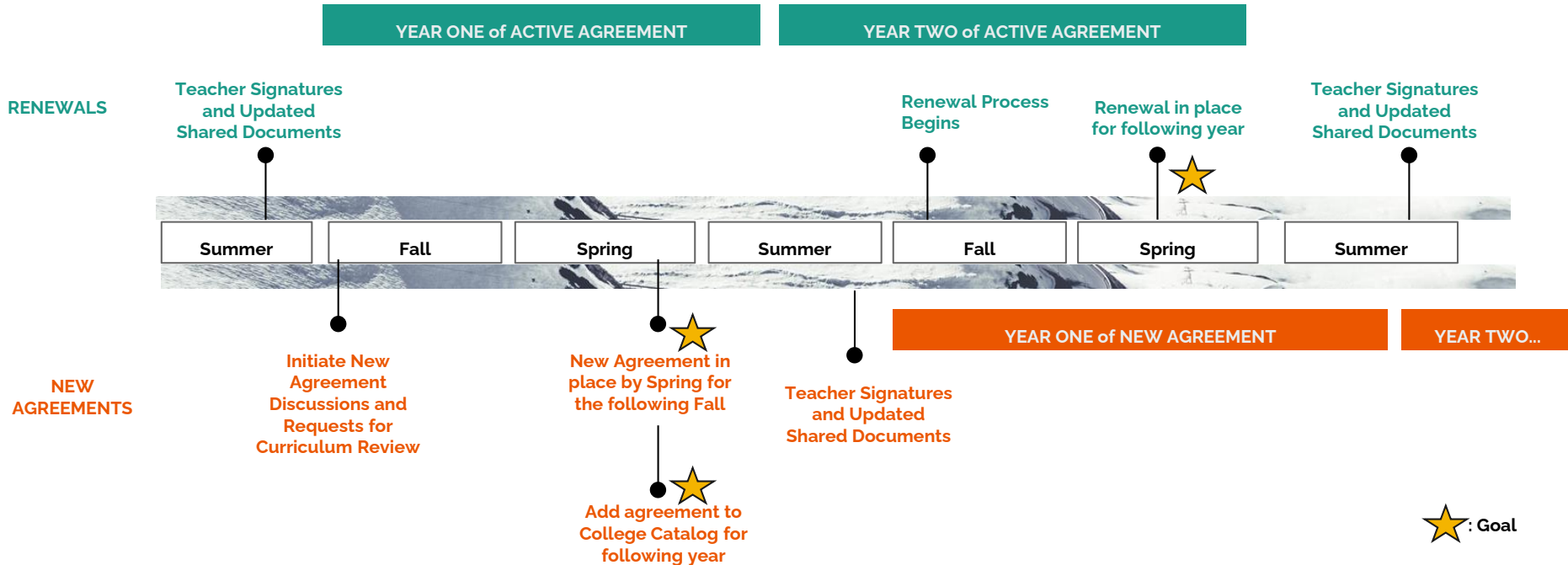
## Implementation

- ★ Agreement written to include all components of the partnership.
- ★ Two-year renewal cycle
- ★ Agreement signed by all participating high school teachers and principals
- ★ Teacher awareness
- ★ Parent and student engagement

## Awarding College Credit

- ★ Course participation and completion
- ★ Official grades
- ★ Exchange of records
- ★ Validation of IDs and student information
- ★ Processing of credit

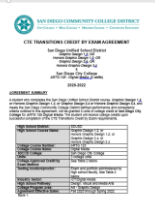
TIMELINE

- Shared comprehensive timeline
- Includes all related departments and roles
- Program year specific; accommodates multiple course patterns

AGREEMENT TEMPLATE

- Includes summary, purpose, roles, and requirements
- Course specific assessment details and requirements
- Annual teacher signatures
- Two-year renewable

MASTER LIST

- Internal partnership tool
- Includes course basics and effective dates
- Tied to College catalog and record keeping

SHARED DATA FILES & INTEGRATED PETITION FORM

- All participants & Qualified participants
- Pre-populated Petition Forms
- Shared insight into status of each student request

05

HIGH SCHOOL ONE-PAGERS

- Teachers, counselors, parents, and students
- Annual high school specific active agreements
- Expanding context - Building Career Pathways into the one-pagers
