

User Guide

WBL SG21 Subcategory queries in Campus Solutions

Two types of WBL SG21 subcategory queries have been developed:

- Student level coding queries
- Section level coding query

Due to the fact that student level coding queries can only be limited by College (CITY, MESA, MIRA, CE) and the College of Continuing Education prefers SDCCE Campus listed (CCHAV, ECC, MCITY, NCCTR, WESTC), CE cannot be limited in the queries and some SDCCE specific queries have been created.

General Student level coding Queries

4	X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21_CE	Shows every CE student level coding entered – term based.
5	X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21_DISTINCT_CE X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21_CE_CAMP_ID	List of IDs with at least one CE student level coding at that Campus – term based.

6	X_SR_WBL_SG21_CLASS_ATTRIBUTES	List of Active Sections with SG21 Subcategory attribute – term based, all institutions
7	X_SR_WBL_SG21_CRSE_ATTRIBUTES	List of Active Sections with SG21 Subcategory attributes because they are coded at the course level (should be all sections)
8	X_SR_WBL_SG21_CRSES_CODED	List of all courses (via Course ID) that have SG21 subcategories coded and college they are offered

- These two queries are the same thing except they appear in a different order. X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21 orders by Campus and then ID. It is unclear how X_SR_MIS_STDNT_ATTR_WBL_SG21 orders. We believe it is the order data was added.
- Term values may be off as they are manually input. Found one value from term "2007".

What it does:	This query provides a pivot table of student level reporting for SG21 subcategories (X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21) counts by Campus and Attr_Value. Students may receive multiple SG21 subcategories and may receive multiple of the same SG21 subcategory in a term. Each entry will be included in this count. The following counts will have to be tallied manually (Districtwide, All Credit Colleges, SDCCE).

What it does:	This query provides a list of IDs with at least one student level SG21 subcategory reported at an SG21 Campus and term. It does not provide information about which SG21 subcategory was recorded or how many SG21 subcategories a student received. This list is unduplicated at the SG21 Campus level (if a student was given an SG21 subcategory at CITY and MESA in the same term they will appear in each SG21 campus list. This is also true for the CE Campuses). The following unduplicated lists will have to be created manually (Districtwide, All Credit Colleges, SDCCE).

- This query is the same as X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21 except it only shows the different Campuses for CE. X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21_CE orders by Campus and then ID.
- Term values may be off as they are manually input. Found one value from a different campus with term "2007".

Information about Query

What it does:	These queries are the same as X_SR_MIS_WBL_SG21_DISTINCT except it does not include any of the credit colleges in SG21 CE Campus. These queries provide a list of IDs with at least one student level SG21 subcategory reported at an SG21 Campus and term. They do not provide information about which SG21 subcategory was recorded or how many SG21 subcategories a student received. This list is unduplicated at the SG21 CE Campus level (if a student was given an SG21 subcategory at CHAV and MCITY in the same term they will appear in each SG21 CE Campus list). An SDCCE unduplicated lists will have to be created manually.

Information about Query

What it does:	This query identifies sections that have SG21 subcategory course attribute coded to a section. A section can have more than one course attribute added and each row represents a single SG21 subcategory value for a section.

Other Notes

- Credit college course attribute values should be added prior to student enrollments. CE Course attributes can be coded until the end of a term.
- Currently the query is only displaying Class stat = "Active". Cancelled or non-active section must be found by going to the source table in Campus Solutions.
- Enrollment Status (Enrl Stat) is determined by the number of seats available in the class. There are three possible Enrollment Statuses; Open, Waitlist, Closed.
 - Open – There are open seats within the Enrollment Capacity (Enrollment Capacity > Enrollment Total)
 - Waitlist – There are open seats within the Waitlist Capacity (Waitlist Capacity > Waitlist Total)
 - Closed – There are no open seats within the Enrollment or Waitlist Capacities (Enrollment Capacity and/or Waitlist Capacity ≤ Enrollment Total and/or Waitlist Total)
- This query, with X_SR_WBL_SG21_CRSE_ATTRIBUTES, can have you identify which sections were coded at the course level or section level by college practitioners.

Information about Query

What it does:	This query identifies courses at the section level that should have an SG21 subcategory value because they are coded at the course level. If a section is blank then the course-level coding is not being done properly. This is expected for new course codes added and schedules have already rolled over.

Other Notes

- Course-level coding was implemented in Summer 2021. Summer 2021 and Fall 2021 sections did not have the subcategory values populating and were manually added to each section (March, 2022). This should not be a problem for Summer 2022 onward.
- This query, with X_SR_WBL_SG21_CLASS_ATTRIBUTES, can have you identify which sections were coded at the course level or section level by college practitioners.
