To simplify credit transfer between institutions, California Community Colleges will implement a statewide numbering system through the Common Course Numbering system. This system will eventually provide a standardized set of subjects and course numbers across all California Community Colleges, ensuring that equivalent courses have the same identifier. By aligning course numbers, students can more easily transfer credits, reducing confusion and streamlining their educational pathway.

The Common Course Numbering system helps students plan their academic path, particularly when transferring to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems. This initiative supports seamless articulation agreements and ensures that students' credits are recognized across the state's diverse community colleges.

Implementing Common Course Numbering

San Diego City, Mesa and Miramar Colleges will begin rolling out the new system in a series of phases. The first phase begins Fall 2025 where the following
