Dear Students,

As we navigate the start of the Fall 2021 semester, it is clear that the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact how we learn, teach, and work. We anticipate offering more on-campus classes and services for Spring 2022, and we want to affirm that, first and foremost, we continue to be committed to your health and safety.

On September 23, 2021, the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) Governing Board passed a resolution giving authority to the Chancellor to enact a vaccine requirement for all students, faculty, and staff.

What This Means

Students enrolled in classes with an on-campus component or utilizing services at any district location must provide proof of full vaccination ([per CDC guidelines](#)) or have an eligible religious or medical exemption on file, or they will be dropped from their class. Vaccination is not required for students enrolled exclusively in online courses or those who do not come on campus; however, SDCCD strongly encourages all district community members to be vaccinated.

SDCCD uses Cleared4 to help provide students a safe, secure way to comply with COVID-19 vaccination and testing requirements. Exempt students are required to comply with weekly COVID-19 testing requirements and upload them through our Cleared4 system.
