\* Active Duty Military, Veterans who were discharged within the past 15 years, Homeless or Foster Youth under 25 years of age may be eligible for priority registration. For information, contact the College Admissions Office by **October 23** for required verification.

\*\* Permits purchased by this date by noon will be mailed. Permits purchased after this date will need to be picked up on campus. Parking permits are required at all times. Day permit machines are available in most student lots.

\*\*\* Holidays – No Saturday or Sunday classes following a Friday Holiday. No Sunday classes before a Monday Holiday.

## California College Promise Grant

The California College Promise Grant (CCPG) is a state funded aid program that waives the enrollment fee for income eligible California residents. Students may apply for the CCPG one of two ways:

- Submit a FAFSA (<https://fafsa.ed.gov>)
- OR
- Submit a California Dream Act Application (<https://dream.csac.ca.gov>)
